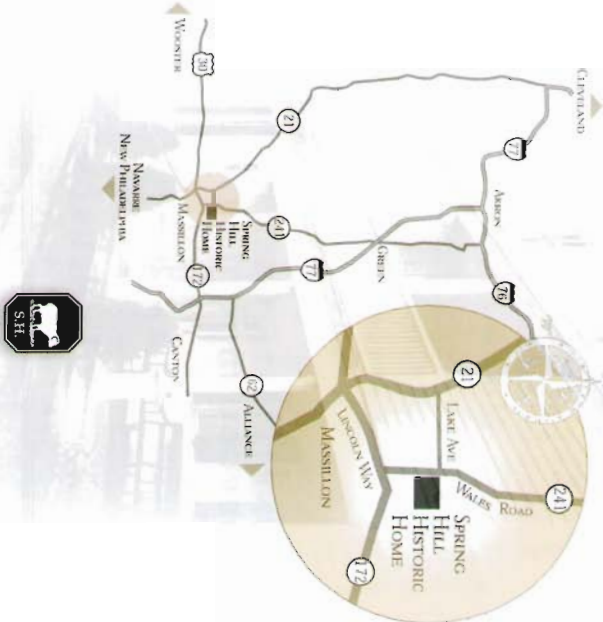

# SPRING HILL HISTORIC HOME

**Spring Hill**, built in 1821 in the former town of Kendal, was the farm home of Quakers Thomas and Charity Rotch and, subsequently, three generations of the Wales family. The home was a station on the Underground Railroad in the mid-1800s. For 150 years the residents of Spring Hill were integral to the social, cultural and economic growth of early Massillon.



Today visitors can experience life as it was in 19th century Ohio. The carefully preserved home and its grounds, featuring original furnishings and period outbuildings, continue to welcome visitors with entertaining and educational tours, displays and relaxing open areas.



Spring Hill Historic Home is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and the National Park Service Underground Railroad Network to Freedom.
